


# Methods to Achieve Accountability

Provide Funding for Federal Oversight



Create New Positions at DOJ to Investigate and Prosecute Violations of the ADA by State Courts and Federal Criminal Laws by Participants in State Guardianship Proceedings

Shift Paradigm from Substituted Decision-Making To Supported Decision-Making As Required by CRPD Treaty Signed by 166 Nations
