





Decision-Making Capacity

Birth to 18 = Presumption of Parental Authority

18 and over = Presumption of Authority by Individual







✓ SDM, POA, or Conservatorship



Power of attorney only requires capacity when it is created


SDM requires capacity when created **and at** *all* times later



Conservatorship does not require capacity

Capacity = understanding information, voluntary choices, no undue influence, and no conflict of interest

Supported Decision-Making / Traveling Down the Yellow Brick Road ✓ How to Assess/Create SDM Agreements

Regional Center – IPP Process – (1) Person centered planning with each area of decision-making assessed by a **qualified professional**; (2) **Referral to attorney** (RC-paid vendor) to draft SDM documents; (3) **Effective monitoring** to reduce risk of abuse



Probate Court -- Limited Conservatorship – (1) Petitioner asks for evaluation of adult for less restrictive alternatives in each area of decision-making; (2) court-appointed attorney initiates request for IPP if it was not already done, or appointment of **730 expert(s)**.
