

However, I will attend the Meeting as indicated in my letter to Bill. My understanding is that the charge of my lodging in a double room will be paid for by the Committee for the nights of Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday, if I am unable to catch a Monday evening plane returning to Minneapolis, August 2 through 6. I will pay for my air transportation, to be partially reimbursed, if possible, at a later date. I am very much looking forward to attending the Meeting, and I am confident that it will be a valuable experience for me and I hope that I will be able to make some contributions.

The only thing that I have to add after looking at the proposed agenda is that I note that the problems of gay people in employment does not appear to be covered. I trust that there is some reason for this omission, but I think that it might be valuable to discuss developments in this area especially in view of the disposition by the New York Court of Appeals in the Kimball case, ~~the decision of which I am enclosing.~~ Perhaps this area has been covered in previous meetings, and that it would be redundant to cover it now.
