Dear Committee Member or Guest:

The annual meeting of the National Committee will be held in New York City at Columbia University. This is a preliminary announcement which is intended to help you formulate plans for the meeting. Another announcement with specific details, including forms for registration and accommodations, will be sent to you by April 1st.

I have enclosed a tentative list of panels which will be held at the annual meeting.

The meeting will begin with an informal gathering at the university during the evening of Friday, May 25. Panels will be held on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday, May 26 through May 28. There will be a business meeting on Tuesday, May 29 for Committee members only.

At last year's business meeting it was decided that there should be a registration fee for future meetings. The registration fee will help defray expenses for the meeting. The registration fee for this year's meeting will be \$25.00 (students \$7.50).

Accommodations will be available on the campus at Carmen Hall. Carmen Hall provides suites of 2 rooms with a connecting bath. One or two people may stay in a room. If one person to a room, the rate is \$20.00 per person per night. If two people to a room, the rate is \$16.00 per person per night. These rates are tentative and will be confirmed with the next announcement. The registration fee will be included in the room rates, so that there will be no additional registration fee for those staying at Carmen Hall.


This year's annual meeting is co-sponsored by the New York Gay Academic Union. Several panels will be chaired by members of the Scholarship Committee of the G.A.U.
