

NATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR SEXUAL CIVIL LIBERTIES

Dear Committee Member,

This is your invitation to participate in our business meeting in Washington, D.C. on Saturday and Sunday, November 3 and 4, 1979. We will meet in the North Scott Room of the Gramercy Inn, 1616 Rhode Island Avenue, Northwest. Our meeting will begin promptly at 10 am on Saturday. Coffee and danish will be available in the meeting room after 9:30 am. We will meet at noon on Sunday. No coffee or danish will be available.

The four Washington members--John Bartolomeo, Leonard Graff, Mayo Lee, and I--invite you to have a drink with us at Leonard's apartment between 9 pm and 10:30 pm on Friday, November 2, 1979. Leonard is in apartment 916 at 1415 Rhode Island Avenue, Northwest. You must dial 202 on the house phone at the entrance. Those of you who are staying with friends in the area are encouraged to bring them along. We are inviting some Washington friends who will be interested in the Committee and the work of its members.

Enclosed with this letter are the following:

1. Gramercy Inn pamphlet.
2. Gramercy Inn room reservation card. I have reserved a limited number of rooms for the Committee's use at a rate of \$45.00 per night for a single room and \$55.00 per night for a double room. If you will need a hotel room, you must return the card to the Gramercy Inn by October 12, 1979. If you wish to arrive after 6 pm and have a guaranteed reservation, you must pay for one night when you make the reservation. If you forget to mention the Committee at the bottom of the card, you may not get a room as rooms are often unavailable in Washington. (I had lunch at the hotel and both the variety of the menu and the prices it listed were pleasantly surprising.)
3. Metro pamphlet. If you plan to arrive at either Union Station or National Airport, the subway will be the most economical means of getting to the hotel, or for getting around downtown Washington. The hotel is on the south side of Rhode Island Avenue, Northwest, between 16th and 17th Streets, Northwest. It is just three blocks from the Farragut North station on the subway's Red Line.
The subway does run on both Saturday and Sunday, although it stops at midnight on Saturday and at 6 pm on Sunday.

If you will arrive at Dulles Airport, you can get express bus or van transportation to downtown hotels, including the Gramercy.


4. Metro schematic map. This map locates various points of interest in relation to the subway stops.
