I wanted to write and let you know that I won't be able to come to the NCSCC meeting in New York City. I have joined the Catholic Worker movement and, though they take care of my basic subsistence needs, I otherwise have no income. I'm living here in the C.W. house in Redwood City near San Francisco. Our work is with teenagers who are in trouble. But I have a good deal of free time for reflection and writing.

My latest effort at writing — a fairly short piece entitled Homosexuality and the Bible: An Interpretation — will be published by Pendle Hill, the Quaker study center in Hallingford, Pennsylvania, as their July pamphlet. I'll send you a copy as soon as it's out. Let me know what you think of it.
